<b>FAQ:</b>	<b>Response:</b>
<b><i>Is there a lot of Homework?</i></b>	Homework is structured the same as GCSE, you get a Knowledge organiser per topic. This is formatted the same way as you are familiar with at GCSE and have to complete one week of tasks per week.
<b><i>Is the gap between GCSE and A-Level big?</i></b>	At GCSE you have already been taught all of the tenses and A-level mainly consolidates these and is more so about learning about the culture and the French speaking world.
<b><i>How does the speaking exam work?</i></b>	Arguably, at A-Level speaking is the easiest element of the exam due to the fact you have control over what you talk about – it is your exam, so you guide it. You have to respond to a photo card and complete a presentation around a topic of your choice in relation to French speaking countries.
