FAQ:	Response:
What grade at GCSE Physics do I need to allow me to take Physics A'level	Grade 7 is the minimum grade accepted.
Do I need to take A'level Maths to do A'level Physics?	The simple answer is no. Taking A'level maths would help and compliment parts of the physics course. However, it is not essential, and we have had students in the past who did not take maths but went on and achieved a grade A.
What textbooks do we get?	Students will be given a CGP Physics revision guide and will be given access to a virtual textbook as well. In the upper 6th all students will receive a copy of the EDEXCEL textbook
Do I know which teacher I will get?	Unfortunately, the answer is no. The staffing for the timetable takes place at the end of the summer term and becomes live at the start of the new academic year. It is important that you are choosing Physics for the subject itself and not for the teacher who teaches it.
