FAQ:	Response:
Is it necessary to study A level Law to study Law at university?	No, many students study Law at university without doing A level Law. However, A level Law covers three major areas of a university course – criminal, civil law and contract. Also, it offers an introduction to legal skills which will be needed in a degree course.
Is it an essay-based subject?	There are some essays but there are shorter response type answers and most of the written work is answering legal problem case studies.
What skills do I need to do well at A-level Law?	Successful Law students have good language and comprehension skills, logical minds and an ability to present a legal argument.
Is there any formal coursework?	No this is an entirely exam-based subject.
