A very busy three day NSYF programme in June saw Y12 students benefit from a range of interactive sessions as part of our post-18 UCAS / Apprenticeship support programme.

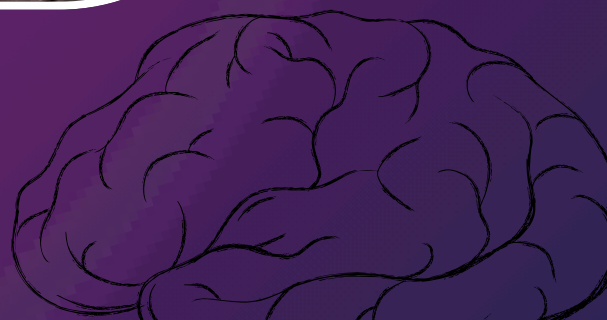
MINDS & PSG

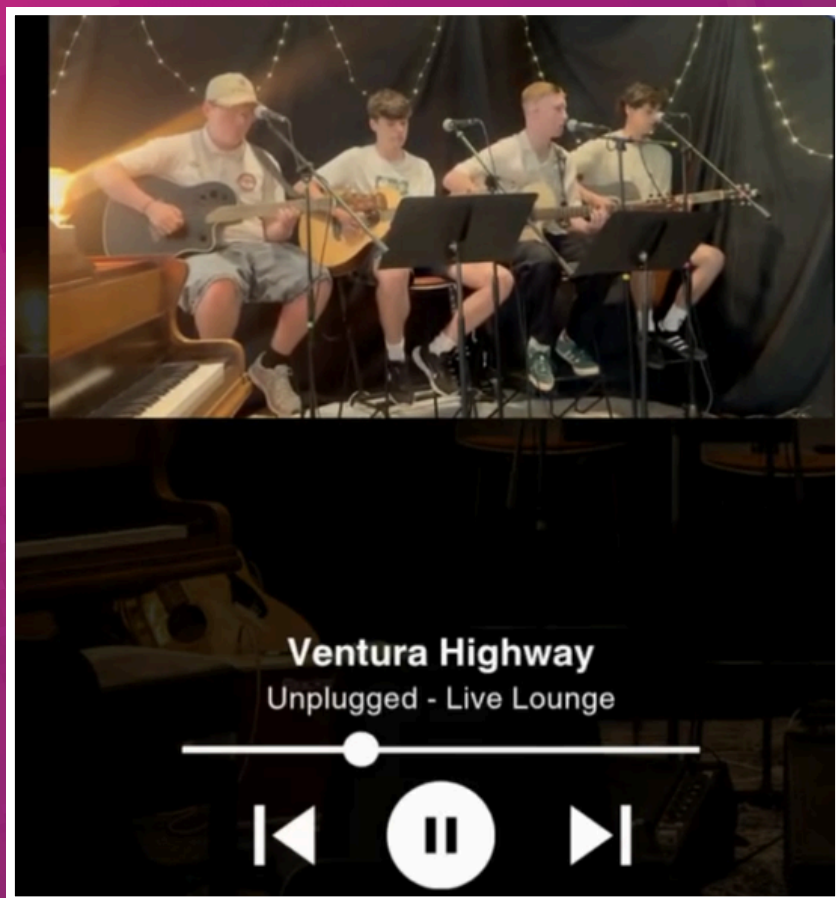
