Admission to WGS6: details of Enrolment / Results Day August 20th 2026

I hope that you are enjoying a well-deserved rest after your GCSE examinations.

Further to your application to join WGS6, we hope you are still looking forward to starting your post-16 journey with us.

I would now like to provide some detail regarding arrangements for results day and the acceptance and confirmation of your place at WGS6 in September.

The following is a reminder of the terms of the conditional offer made to you following submission of your application form.

As a guide, students typically enter the Sixth Form with a minimum of 6 GCSE grades at 9-5, or their equivalent, including English and Mathematics. Our prime concern is for students to embark on courses that are appropriate for their ability. A grade 6 or 7 is considered a solid starting point to continue a subject to A level. All requests for admission to sixth form are considered on an individual basis.

Results Day Arrangements.

On Thursday 20th August you are invited to attend our enrolment event which follows on from our own GCSE results event. This will be an opportunity to share and discuss your results and whether they have met the conditions of your offer. There will also be an opportunity to discuss your preferred A level options, including any possible option changes, although these will not be actioned until Wed 2nd September.

Please bring with you a paper copy of your results once you have collected them from your school.

Due to the numbers of potential students attending this enrolment event, please attend according to the following time slots; if you have any issues pertaining to the timeslot you are allocated to, or cannot join us on the day, please notify us in advance via WGS6Admissions@wirralgrammarboys.com and we will discuss alternative arrangements.

We very much hope you are successful in meeting our admissions criteria, but please be aware that we are a high attaining Sixth Form and are keen to ensure that all our students will flourish in our academic setting. **If your results do not meet our criteria, it may be that we are unable to offer you a place, or you may be placed on a reserve list pending further consultation.**

Please remember to bring **paper version of your GCSE results** to discuss in your 1:1 meeting with a member of the Sixth Form Team.

A subsequent meeting, call or email dialogue may follow to discuss individual circumstances.

For those successful in gaining a place at WGS6:

On **Wednesday 2nd September 2026**, we will be holding an induction event 'Preparing for WGS6' which will provide an opportunity to find out more about sixth form life as well as offering you guidance on making the transition from GCSE to A-level study.

On this day, WGS6 students are expected to arrive via the atrium (main student entrance) by 8:55am where they will be met and directed to the WGS6 area opposite our staffroom. The school day will finish at 3:40pm. Please dress according to our WGS6 uniform policy, details of which can be found via the 'Dress to Impress' button [on this webpage](#).

For the first day or so, it may be advisable for students to bring a packed lunch and/or money for purchasing food and drinks from local shops at break or lunch (when you will be permitted to leave site). It will take a few days to ensure new students are enrolled onto our cashless catering and ICT systems.

On Induction Day, we would be grateful if you could also bring your **passport or birth certificate** to allow us to take a copy for our records.

Further information:

In addition to three A-level subjects, some students may be invited to study the AQA Extended Project Qualification. This is a valuable qualification and can result in lower offers being made from universities; it is also a significant opportunity to develop independent study skills and pursue an academic interest which complements A-level study. More details about this will be shared in the autumn term.
